Garbage Pick up days for November Holidays

Residential Garbage pick up:

If your regular pick up is on Veterans Day, Wednesday Nov 11, you will get picked up the next day, Thursday Nov 12.

If your regular pick up is on Thanksgiving, Thursday Nov 26, or Friday November 27, you will get picked up on Saturday, November 28.

Commercial Garbage pick up:

If your regular pick up is on Veterans Day, Wednesday Nov 11, you will get picked up the next day, Thursday Nov 12.

If your regular pick up is on Thanksgiving, Thursday Nov 26, you will get picked up the day before, Wednesday Nov 25.

If your regular pick up is on the day after Thanksgiving, Friday Nov 27, you will get picked up the day after, Saturday Nov 28.

FALL CLEAN UP October 19-November 16.



Materials to be picked up must be out at the curb away from your garbage can. Our Street Department will try to pick up materials on your scheduled garbage pick up day, but may be a day after.

Please bag or bundle materials as much as possible so they may be picked up by hand. If the City has to use heavy equipment to load trees, branches, etc. you will be notified, and may be charged for equipment use. Limbs & branches should be bundled and cut no longer than 6' lengths. We will not be able to pick up bagged sod.
