



ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DISPOSAL OF DEAD ANIMALS FOUND WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG; AND PROVIDING FOR THE BURIAL OF SUCH ANIMALS IN CASE THE OWNER CANNOT BE FOUND, AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED: BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, FREMONT COUNTY, IDAHO:

SECTION I: DEAD ANIMALS TO BE BURIED BY THEIR OWNERS WHEN KNOWN

It shall be the duty, and it is hereby required of every person who may be the owner of any animal of whatsoever kind, which may be found dead within the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg, to remove such dead animal without the limits of the said Village, or to bury same into the ground of a sufficient depth so that the other side will be three feet below the surface thereof.

SECTION II: CITY MARSHAL TO BURY THEM WHEN OWNERS NOT KNOWN

It shall be the duty of the City marshal, and is hereby required of him to bury all dead animals found within the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg, under the directions of the Board of Trustees of said Village; provided however that the owner of such dead animal cannot be found after diligent search, and provided further that the owner after three hours notice refuses to bury such dead animal, or remove same from the corporate limits of said Village as required in Sec. 1 of this ordinance.

SECTION III: COMPENSATION FOR

The City Marshal shall receive as compensation for his services for the burying of dead animals as required by the provisions of this ordinance three dollars for any dead horse, ass, cow or calf and one dollar for any other animal.

SECTION IV: A MISDEMEANOR TO DISOWN, OR FOR OWNERS TO REFUSE TO BURY DEAD ANIMALS

Any person willfully disowning a dead animal found within the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg, after being notified as provided for in Sec. 2 of this ordinance for the purpose of avoiding the requirements of the owners of such animals under the provision of this ordinance, or willfully failing to comply with the requirements of this ordinance shall on conviction thereof be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined not less than five dollars or more than twenty dollars and the costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such judgment shall be imprisoned in the Village jail, and work upon the streets of the Village of Rexburg at the rate of two dollars per day until said fine and costs are paid.

SECTION V: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty days after its passage and approval.
