ORDINANCE 3

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF MINORS UNDER SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE FROM PLAYING UPON THE STREETS AND ROAMING ABOUT THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO, AFTER EIGHT O'CLOCK IN THE EVENING OF EACH DAY DURING THE MONTHS OF OCTOBER, NOVEMBER, DECEMBER, JANUARY, FEBRUARY, AND MARCH, AND PROHIBITING MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF SIXTEEN YEARS FROM PLAYING UPON THE STREETS AND ROAMING ABOUT SAID VILLAGE AFTER NINE O'CLOCK IN THE EVENING OF EACH DAY DURING THE MONTHS OF APRIL, MAY, JUNE, JULY, AUGUST, AND SEPTEMBER; AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: It shall be unlawful for any minor or minors under the age of sixteen years, to play upon the streets, or to roam about the village of Rexburg, Idaho, unaccompanied by their parents or guardians after eight o'clock in the evening of each day during the months of October, November December, January, February, and March.

SECTION II: It shall be unlawful for any minor or minors under the age of sixteen years to play upon the streets or roam about the village of Rexburg, Idaho, unaccompanied by their parents, or guardians after nine o'clock in the evening of each day during the months of April, May, June, July, August, and September.

SECTION III: Any minor or minors violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding ten dollars (\$10.00), and costs of conviction, and upon failure to pay the same shall be incarcerated in the village jail until said fine and costs are paid.

SECTION IV: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its passage and approval.
