



ORDINANCE NO 5

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE OBSTRUCTION OF THE SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, AND RELATING TO THE EXCAVATION OF EARTH UNDER SAID SIDEWALKS, AND RELATING TO THE OBSTRUCTIONS OF THE STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THE VILLAGE OF REXBURG, AND RELATING TO THE OBSTRUCTION OF AND MALICIOUS INJURY TO RAILROADS, AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Rexburg, Idaho:

SECTION I: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to obstruct any part of the sidewalks within the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg with building material or any other material without permission of the Board of Trustees of said Village first obtained in writing.

SECTION II: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to excavate the earth from the sidewalks or from under the plank sidewalks within the corporate limits of the said Village of Rexburg for cellars, or pits, or for any purpose.

SECTION III: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to lead, drive, or ride any horse, mule, or any other beast of burden upon any sidewalk within the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg.

SECTION IV: Any person or persons who obstructs, injures, or damages any of the streets or alleys of the Village of Rexburg, either by placing obstruction therein, or by digging in, or by deepening or deviating the water of any stream, or by placing any obstruction in any ditch or stream within or along any of the streets or alleys of the Village of Rexburg; or placing or constructing any obstruction, ditch or embankments upon their own or other lands so as to make or cause any water to flow upon or impair any of the streets or alleys of the Village of Rexburg; or in any other manner injures or obstructs any of the streets or alleys of the Village of Rexburg, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION V: Any person or persons, who maliciously removes, displaces, injures, or destroys any part of any railroad, whether for steam or horse cars, or any track of any railroad, or any branch or branch way, switch, turnout, bridge, viaduct, culvert, embankment, station house, or other structure or fixture, or any part thereof attached to or connected with any railroad; or places any obstruction upon the rails or tracks of any railroad, or any switch, branch, branchway or turnout connected with any railroad; within the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg is guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION VI: Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, and upon conviction thereof, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined in any sum not to exceed fifty dollars and costs of conviction, and in default thereof may be imprisoned in the Village jail and be compelled to work upon the streets of said Village at the rate of two dollars per day until said fine and costs are paid.

SECTION VII: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty days after its passage and approval.
