ORDINANCE NO. 61

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE ANNUAL ASSESSMENT ON THE CITY CANAL, AND PROVIDING HOW MUCH ASSESSMENT SHALL BE PAID.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I – That there shall be, and is hereby levied an assessment of five dollars and twenty cents on each share of capital stock of the City Canal; two dollars and seventy cents per share to be paid in labor under the direction of the city water master, and two dollars and fifty cents per share to be paid in cash to the City Clerk at his office.

SECTION II – That said assessment as provided for in section one of this ordinance shall be due on or before the first day of May, 1903, and be delinquent on the 15th day of May, 1903.

SECTION III – All stockholders or subscribers who are delinquent in their assessments shall forfeit their right to the use of any water from the city canal for irrigation purposes until said delinquent assessments are paid in full.
