



**ORDINANCE NO. 86**

**AN ORDINANCE TO LICENSE BOWLING ALLEYS, BILLIARD AND POOL TABLES, AND PRESCRIBING CERTAIN LIMITATIONS, AND PROVIDING SUITABLE PENALTIES FOR THEIR VIOLATION AND REPEALING SECTION 72.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG;

**SECTION I** – There is hereby levied and shall be paid into the city treasury, by the owner, proprietor, lessee, keeper, manager or operator of any bowling alley, or alleys, billiard or pool table or tables, operated within the corporate limits of the City of Rexburg, a license tax as follows, to-wit:

For a single alley	\$15.00 per quarter
For each additional alley	5.00 per quarter
For each billiard or pool table	10.00 per quarter
For each additional pool or billiard table	5.00 per quarter

ny game not expressed in the title of this ordinance is prohibited, wherein such games are played.

**SECTION II** – All persons engaged in the business of operating any bowling alley or alleys, billiard or pool table or tables within the corporate limits of the City of Rexburg without first procuring a license as provided and required by Section I of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof for such violation shall be fined in any sum not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

**SECTION III** – All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

An emergency existing this ordinance is in effect when passed and approved by the mayor.
