ORDINANCE NO. 87

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR PROPRIETORS, OPERATORS OR OWNERS OF BOWLING ALLEYS, BILLIARD TABLES OR POOL TABLES TO ALLOW OR PERMIT MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS, OR FOR SUCH MINORS TO PLAY ANY OF SAID GAMES OR TO SIT OR FREQUENT PLACES WHERE SUCH GAMES ARE PLAYED, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I – It shall be unlawful for the proprietor, operator or owner of any bowling alley, billiard table or pool table to allow or permit any minor under the age of Eighteen years to play any of the games hereinbefore mentioned or to visit or frequent places where such games are played.

SECTION II – It shall be unlawful for minors under the age of Eighteen years to visit or frequent places where any of the games hereinbefore mentioned are played or to play any of said games in said places.

SECTION III – All persons violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed Twenty Five Dollars (\$45.00) and committed to the custody of the Chief of Police until such fine is paid or satisfied.

SECTION IV – This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
