ORDINANCE NO. 88

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE HOLDING OF GENERAL AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS; FOR THE ISSUANCE OF ELECTION PROCLAMATIONS; PROVIDING WHAT OFFICERS SHALL BE ELECTED AT SUCH ELECTIONS AND THE MANNER OF HOLDING SUCH ELECTIONS, AND APPOINTING THE CITY CLERK TO ACT AS CITY REGISTRAR, AND REPEALING SECTIONS 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, AND 29 OF CHAPTER 9 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO;

SECTION I – That at least 30 days before each general election the mayor shall issue an election proclamation containing a statement of the time and place of election, the purpose of said election, and the offices to be filled at such election.

SECTION II – That at least 20 days prior to any general or special election in said city the clerk of said city shall make a copy of the registered electors within the City of Rexburg, as shown from the last registration lists on file with the clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Fremont County, and shall place on said copied list the names of all additional electors who apply to him for registration at any time up to the Saturday night preceding the election, and the said City Clerk is hereby constituted the registration officer for all city elections and the said copied list as aforesaid shall constitute the official registration list of said city. All provisions of the state law providing for the Judges and Clerks of election, places of holding elections, furnishing of supplies, filing certificates of nominations, and other necessary procedure in city elections, shall be the same as provided for the general state and county election, the necessary changes and substitution being made therein.

SECTION III – That the compensation of the registrar shall be fixed by the Mayor and City Council and the Judges and Clerks of any election shall receive \$2.00 for their services during any election.
