**ORDINANCE NO. 90**

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE REVENUES FOR THE  
MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY CANAL.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
REXBURG, IDAHO;

**SECTION I** – That there be, and is hereby levied an assessment of two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) on each share of capital stock of the city canal; two dollars a share to be paid in labor under the direction of the city water master, and fifty cents a share to be paid cash to the city clerk (ex-officio secretary of city canal) at his office, Main St., Rexburg.

**SECTION II** – That said assessment as provided for in section one of this ordinance shall be due on the first day of May, 1905, and delinquent on the fifteenth day of May, 1905, and delinquent stock owners, or water uses of the city canal shall be prohibited the use of water from the city canal for irrigating purposes during the time that said assessment shall remain delinquent.

**SECTION III** – That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed.
