**ORDINANCE NO. 92**

**THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING FUNDS FOR THE DISBURSEMENT OF THE CITY REVENUES, APPORTIONING THE REVENUES OF THE CITY AND APPROPRIATING THE SAME FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING THE FIRST TUESDAY, 1905, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO.

**SECTION I** – That there be, and is hereby created for the fiscal year commencing the first Tuesday in May, 1905, the following funds, to-wit:

The General Fund, the Ditch Fund, the Road & Bridge Fund, the Cemetery Fund, and none others, except as may be provided hereafter by ordinance.

**SECTION II** – That all warrants now outstanding, and unredeemed for the want of funds that were drawn on the general improvement fund, the contingent fund, and the electric light fund for the fiscal year end May 1<sup>st</sup>, 1905, shall be redeemed by the General Expense Fund, as provided for in section one of this ordinance.

**SECTION III** – That all moneys received from sale of cemetery lots be, and is hereby apportioned to the Cemetery Fund,

That all moneys received from assessments on city canal be, and is hereby apportioned to the Ditch Fund,

That all moneys received from road poll taxes be, and is hereby apportioned to the Road & Bridge Fund.

That all moneys received from the annual tax levy on city property be, and is hereby apportioned as follow: Five per cent to the Cemetery Fund, thirty per cent to the Road and Bridge Fund, and sixty five per cent to the General Expense Fund.

That all moneys received from other sources not otherwise apportioned be, and the same is hereby apportioned to the General Expense Fund.

**SECTION IV** – That there be and is hereby appropriated to the Cemetery Fund, \$250.00.

That there be and is hereby appropriated to the Road & Bridge Fund, \$1,250.00.

That there be and is hereby appropriated to the Ditch Fund, \$350.00.

That there be and is hereby appropriated to the General Expense Fund \$6,290.00

**SECTION V** – That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
