**VILLAGE ORDINANCE  
ENTITLED  
“THE APPROPRIATION BILL”**

**LEVYING A TAX FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING THE FIRST TUESDAY IN MAY, AD, 1899 AND APPROPRIATING THE SAME.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Rexburg, Idaho:

**SECTION I:** That a levy of seven (7) mills on the Dollar be, and is hereby made on all taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of Rexburg, Idaho, taxable according to the laws of the State of Idaho, for the fiscal year beginning the first Tuesday of May, A.D. 1899.

**SECTION II:** That there be, and is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the Village of Rexburg – as provided for in Section One of this Ordinance – as follows, to wit:

To the General Fund, forty per cent (40%).

To the Road and Bridge Fund, fifty per cent (50%).

To the Cemetery Fund ten per cent (10%).

**SECTION III:** That all revenues from other sources, the expenditure of which is not otherwise provided for by law or Ordinance, shall be appropriated to the General Fund.

PASSED and approved this 17<sup>th</sup> Day of May A.D. 1899.
