



ORDINANCE NO. 101

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN ASSESSMENT OF CASH AND LABOR ON THE CITY CANAL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, COUNTY OF MADISON, STATE OF IDAHO:

SECTION I: There is hereby levied the sum of two dollars and fifty cents (2.50) per share on each share of capital stock of the City Canal.

One dollar to be paid in labor under the directions of the City Watermaster and (1.50) to be paid in cash to the City Clerk at his office on Main Street Rexburg.

Said Assessment shall be delinquent on the 15th day of May 1906.

An emergency existing this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
