



ORDINANCE NO. 115

AMENDING SECTION 81 CHAPTER XI, PART 1, OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, RELATING TO SALARIES AND FEES AND PROVIDING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION I: That Section 81 of Chapter XI, Part I. of the revised ordinances of the City of Rexburg be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 81: The salaries and fees of all the officers of the City of Rexburg be the same elected or appointed shall be fixed and regulated as follows, to-wit:

The Mayor shall have and receive as full compensation for his services as such officer, the sum of \$100 per annum.

The City Clerk shall have and receive as full compensation for his services as such officer, the sum of \$30 per month.

The City Treasurer shall have and receive as full compensation for his services as such officer, a sum equal to one per cent of any and all moneys coming to his hands as Treasurer and belonging to the City of Rexburg.

The City Engineer shall have and receive for his services as such officer, a sum of \$4.00 per day, for each day; actual services rendered the City.

The City Attorney shall have and receive as compensation for his services defined in the first four such divisions of Section 39, the sum of \$230 per annum.

The Supervisor of Streets and Wastewater combined shall have and receive the sum of \$55 per month for and during the time of actual service for the City.

The Pound Keeper shall have and receive as full compensation for his services the sum of \$100 per annum.

The Chief of Police shall have and receive as full compensation for his services as such officer the sum of \$60 per month.

The salary of councilmen shall be and is hereby fixed to be the sum of \$ 50 per annum, in full as their compensation for such services.
