



ORDINANCE NO. 124

PROVIDING REVENUES FOR MAINTENANCES OF THE CITY CANAL AND FIXING THE ACCOUNT OF ASSESSMENTS ON EACH SHARE OF STOCK FOR THE YEAR 1908.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO.

SECTION I: That there be and is hereby levied an assessment of two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) on each share of capital stock of the city canal, to be paid in cash to the secretary of the city canal, at his office, Main Street, Rexburg.

SECTION II: Said assessment as provided for in Section I of this Ordinance shall be due and payable on the 20th day of April, 1908, and shall become delinquent on the 20th day of May, 1908, and all delinquent stock owners or water users of the city canal shall be prohibited the use of water from the city canal for irrigation or any other purpose during the time said assessments shall remain delinquent, the time said assessment shall remain delinquent.

SECTION III: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
