ORDINANCE NO. 148

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING REVENUES FOR MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY CANAL AND FIXING THE AMOUNT OF ASSESSMENT ON EACH SHARE OF STOCK FOR THE YEAR 1911.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO

SECTION I: That there be, and is hereby levied an assessment of two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) on each share of capital stock of the city canal at his office, Center Street, Rexburg.

SECTION II: Said assessment as provided for in Section I. of this ordinance shall be due and payable on the 18th day of April, 1911 and shall become delinquent on the 18th day of May, 1911, and all delinquent stock owners of water users of the city canal shall be prohibited the use of water from the city canal for irrigation or any other purpose during the time said assessment shall remain delinquent.

SECTION III: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
