ORDINANCE NO. 161

ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL, 1912

AN ORDINANCE APPORTIONING AND APPROPRIATING THE REVENUES OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, TO THE SEVERAL FUNDS ENTITLED THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG:

SECTION I – That all moneys received from the sale of cemetery lots during the year 1912 be and the same are hereby appropriated to the cemetery fund;

That all moneys received from Road Poll Tax be and the same are hereby appropriated to the Road and Bridge fund;

That all moneys received from the assessment of the City Canal be and the same are hereby appropriated to the ditch fund.

That all moneys received from the general property tax assessment on property within the corporate limits of the said city be and the same are hereby apportioned and appropriated to the following funds, to wit: Fifty per cent thereof to the General Expense fund and fifty per cent to the Road and Bridge fund;

That all moneys received from the special tax assessment for the payment of interest on bonds and the creation of a sinking fund be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purpose of paying such interest on bonds outstanding, and any surplus covered into the sinking fund;

That all moneys received from all other sources not otherwise apportioned or appropriated be and the same are hereby appropriated to the general expense fund.
