ORDINANCE NO. 163

PROVIDING REVENUES FOR MAINTAINANCE OF THE CITY CANAL AND FIXING THE AMOUNT OF ASSESSMENT ON EACH SHARE OF STOCK FOR THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN (1911).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO.

SECTION I: That there be, and is hereby levied an assessment of Three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50) on each share of capital stock of the city canal, to be paid in cash, to the secretary of the city canal at his office, center street, Rexburg.

SECTION II: Said assessment as provided for in Section I of this ordinance, shall be due and payable on the 26th day of April, 1913 and shall become delinquent on the 26th day of May, 1913, and all the delinquent stock owners or water users of the city canal shall be prohibited the use of water from the city canal for irrigation or any other purpose during the time said assessment shall remain delinquent.

SECTION III: All ordinances and parts or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
