



ORDINANCE NO. 187

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION, DESIGNATING CERTAIN FUNDS AND MAKING APPROPRIATION THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COU7NCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IN THE COUNTY OF MADISON, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO;

SECTION I: That all moneys coming into the hands of the City Treasurer of the City of Rexburg, from taxation, licenses, fines, forfeitures, penalties, fees, rents and all other sources whatsoever shall be and the same are hereby apportioned to the following designated funds, to-wit;

SECTION II: That there is hereby appropriated from the General Expense fund the sum of \$10,000.00 for the purpose of defraying the general expenses of the city, the paying of salaries, interests, police, firemen, fire department and such other general expenses incident to he management and conduct of the said city business.

SECTION III: There is hereby appropriated from the Water Works Fund the sum of \$10,000.00 for the purpose of installation of pumps, extension of water mains an laterals, building reservoirs, maintaining and repairing the water works system and such other and further expense necessary and incidental to the management and control of the water system.

SECTION IV: There is hereby appropriated from the Road and Bridge Fund the sum of \$4,000.00 for the purpose of leveling, grading and graveling the streets, alleys and highways of the City of Rexburg, and for sprinkling, repairing and maintaining bridges over, across and upon the streets, alleys, and highways of the city.

SECTION V: There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$100.00 out of the Ditch Fund for the purpose of cleaning, repairing, and maintaining canals and laterals, and for the construction of head gates, weirs and flumes.

SECTION VI: There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$120.00 out of the Cemetery Fund for the purpose of laying of sidewalks, cleaning grounds, repairing ditches, planting trees, repairing fences and other improvements of the city cemetery.

SECTION VII: That all revenues received from any source whatsoever and not otherwise appropriated shall be apportioned to the General Expense Fund.

WHEREAS an emergency exists, therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect immediately upon its passages, approval and publication.
