ORDINANCE NO. 188

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE RATE OF TAX LEVY UPON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, COUNTY OF MADISON, STATE OF IDAHO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IN THE COUNTY OF MADISON, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO.

SECTION I: There is hereby levied a tax of one dollar and thirty cents on each one hundred dollars of taxable property in the city of Rexburg, in the County of Madison, in the state of Idaho, for the fiscal year beginning the last Tuesday in April, A.D. 1915, and ending the last Tuesday in April, A.D. 1916, said tax to be assessed and collected as other taxes are assessed and collected and to be used by the said city as follows, to-wit:

General Expense – Eight mills
Water Works – One mill
Road and Bridges – Four mills

WHEREAS, an emergency exists therefor this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.
