**ORDINANCE NO. 199**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 45 AND SECTION 49 OF  
CHAPTER 11 PART 2 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY  
OF REXBURG, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**SECTION I** – That section 45 of Chapter 11 of part 2 of the revised ordinance of the City of Rexburg, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 45 – Any person not being a property owner in said cemetery desiring to have an internment made must accompany the application for same with the sum of five dollars which, exclusive of the sexton's fees, is hereby established as a price for ground sufficient for a single grave. No deed shall be given for a single grave, but the entrees made by the clerk in the records shall be sufficient evidence of such purchase. No internment shall be made except upon the certificate of the clerk as above mentioned and as directed therein.

**SECTION II** – That Section 49 of Chapter 11 of Part 11 of the revised ordinance of the City of Rexburg be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 49 – The minimum price to be paid for any single lot in said cemetery shall be fifteen dollars (\$15.00) each and upon payment to the city clerk of the usual fee for making deed, he shall make and convey to the original purchaser his heirs or assigns a deed for said lot or lots when two or more persons apply it the same time for the same lot or parcel of ground it shall be sold to the highest bidder provided such bid shall not be less than fifteen dollars (\$15.00).

**SECTION III** – Whereas an emergency exists this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.
