



ORDINANCE NO. 202

ORDINANCE OF INTENTION TO CREATE AND ESTABLISH LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 8, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CEMENT SIDEWALKS UPON PORTIONS OF COLLEGE AVENUE AND CENTER STREET IN SAID DISTRICT, THE COST OF WHICH IS TO BE ASSESSED AND LEVIED UPON THE PROPERTY BENEFITED BY SUCH IMPROVEMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, COUNTY OF MADISON, STATE OF IDAHO:

SECTION I: That it is the intention of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rexburg, Madison County, State of Idaho to create and establish in said city a local improvement district, to be known as “Local Improvement District No. 8.”

SECTION II: That the names of the streets to be improved and the character of such improvement is as follows:

College Avenue: A ten foot cement sidewalk on both sides of College Avenue between Main Street and First South Street; an 8 foot cement sidewalk on both sides of College Avenue between First South and Second South Street;

Center Street: A 5 foot cement sidewalk on the Westside of Center Street between Second South Street and Third South Street

SECTION III: That the improvements to be made in said proposed local improvement district to be made according to ordinance, plans and specification on file in the office of the City Clerk.

SECTION IV: That the estimated cost of construction of said sidewalks is twelve (12) cents per square foot, and the total estimated cost \$1,500.00.

SECTION V: That the cost and expenses of said improvement are to be assessed against the property abutting, fronting, contiguous or tributary (and included in said district) on the said streets proposed to be improved, and shall be assessed in proportion to the number of feet of such property fronting on the streets to be improved or included in said improvement district, and in proportion to the benefits derived by such improvement.

SECTION VI: That all persons who may desire to protest against the making of the improvement mentioned and the creation of said proposed local improvement, may file there written protest against said proposed improvement in the office of the City Clerk at any time prior to 8 o'clock p.m. on Wednesday the 17th day of July, 1916, at which time and place the mayor and City Council of said City will meet and consider any such protests therefore filed and will determine whether or not to proceed with said improvements.

SECTION VII: That the City Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to give due and legal notice hereof, by causing this ordinance to be published in the Rexburg Standard the official newspaper of the City for two consecutive weeks preceding the 17th day of July, 1916.

Whereas, an emergency exists therefor this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication.

PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR this 28th day of June, 1916.
