



**ORDINANCE NO. 225**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF SEC 41 OF CHAPTER 1, OF PART 1, OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF REXBURG RELATING TO THE BREAKING OF THE CITY POUND AND THE TAKING OR ATTEMPTING TO TAKE ANIMALS FROM THE CUSTODY OF THE CITY POUND KEEPER OR HIS DEPUTIES WHILE ON THE WAY TO SAID POUND.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF REXBURG:

**SECTION I:** That Sec 41 of chapter 1, part 1 of the revised ordinances of the City of Rexburg, Idaho be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 41: Any person or persons guilty of breaking the city pound or taking there from any cattle, horses, sheep or swine, or other animals that have been impounded, or shall take or attempt to take the same from the city pound keeper or his deputies while on the way to the pound shall upon conviction thereof before the Police Judge, be fined in any sum not less than ten nor more than one hundred dollars and the costs of prosecution, and be confined in the City Jail until such fine and costs are paid.

**SECTION II:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the passage by the Council and approved by the Mayor, and proclamation.
