



ORDINANCE NO. 233

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ON ALL THE PROPERTY IN LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS NOS. 9 & 10, OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, MADISON COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO, THAT IS NOW CHARGEABLE WITH COSTS OF STREET IMPROVEMENTS OF SAID DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE PAYMENT OF INSTALLMENTS OF THE BONDS OF SAID DISTRICT TOGETHER WITH THE INTEREST THEREON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, MADISON COUNTY, IDAHO;

SECTION I – That in conformity with the provisions of Ordinances Nos. 215 and 219 of said city and Section 89 of Chapter 152 of the compiled laws of the State of Idaho there is hereby levied on all the property of Local Improvement Districts Nos. 9 and 10 of the City of Rexburg, Madison County, Idaho, that is now chargeable with the costs of street improvements for said district, a special assessment sufficient to redeem the installments of bonds of said districts for said improvements that shall mature in the year 1920 together with the interest due on said bonds at the maturity of said installment.

SECTION II – Whereas, an emergency exists, therefore this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval, and due publication in an issue of the Rexburg Journal.
