ORDINANCE NO. 234

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DRIVING, DIRECTING, AND PERMITTING OF LOOSE ANIMALS UPON THE HIGHWAYS, STREETS, AND ALLEYS OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, MADISON COUNTY, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, MADISON COUNTY, IDAHO;

SECTION I – Any person or persons, who drives, directs or permits any loose animal or animals upon the highways, streets or alleys of the City of Rexburg, Madison County, Idaho except those hereinafter designated, for any purpose except to take said animal or animals to or from its habitation shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each offence, provided herein, that no loose animal shall be permitted upon College Avenue or upon Main Street between Third East and Second West, except at the intersections thereof, for any purpose whatsoever.

SECTION II – The streets and highways upon which any loose animal or animals may be driven for all purposes are hereby designated as follows, Second North between 4th East and 5th West, Fourth South between Second East, and Fifth East, Second East between northern city limits and Second North, and between Third South and Fourth South, Fourth East between First North and Second North, Main Street between Western City Limits and Fifth West, all of Fifth East and all of Fifth West.

This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the Rexburg Journal as provided by law.
