



ORDINANCE NO. 275

AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE KEEPING FOR USE ANY POOL OR BILLIARD TABLE OR TABLES IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE IN THE CITY OF REXBURG, MADISON COUNTY, IDAHO, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Rexburg, Madison County, State of Idaho:

SECTION I: No person shall use or keep in any public place in this City, any pool or billiard table for hire, without first obtaining a license and paying a tax therefor as herewith provided.

SECTION II: All applications for license contemplated by the preceding sections shall be made to the City Clerk, who shall issue a quarterly license upon payment of a quarterly license of \$7.50 per quarter for each table, the amount is hereby fixed for such quarterly license.

SECTION III: Any person violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$100.00 and shall be committed in the City jail until such fine and costs are paid.

SECTION IV: The said City in lieu of bringing a criminal action may institute civil proceedings to collect all delinquent license taxes.

SECTION V: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION VI: Whereas an emergency exists this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and due publication.
