



**ORDINANCE NO. 279**

**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE CITIZENS OF THE STATE OF IDAHO A LICENSE TO ERECT A SOLDIERS MEMORIAL UPON THAT CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND BELONGING TO THE CITY OF REXBURG, BEGINNING AT A POINT TWENTY-SIX (26) FEET SOUTH OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF BLOCK THIRTY-SIX (36), OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, THENCE SOUTH EIGHTY (80) FEET; THENCE EAST TWENTY (20) RODS; THENCE NORTH EIGHTY (80) FEET; THENCE WEST TWENTY (20) RODS TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXPIRATION OF SAID LICENSE.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rexburg, Madison County, State of Idaho:

**SECTION I:** That there is hereby granted a license to the citizens of the State of Idaho to erect a soldier's memorial building, to be made for, and in behalf of, the citizens of said State upon the following property, situated in Madison County, State of Idaho, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point twenty-six (26) feet South of the Southwest corner of Block thirty-six (36) of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, thence South eighty (80) feet; thence East twenty (20) rods; thence North eighty (80) feet; thence West twenty (20) rods to the place of beginning;

PROVIDED, that said license herein granted shall expire in the event said memorial building is not completed within five years from and after the passage hereof.
