



ORDINANCE NO. 288

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 194, CHAPTER 35, PART TWO, OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, CHANGING THE TIME OF EXPIRATION AND RENEWAL OF DOG LICENSES FROM APRIL FIRST TO JANUARY FIRST OF EACH YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF REXBURG:

SECTION I: Section 194 of Chapter 35, Part Two of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 194: The amount to be paid by each applicant obtaining such license for keeping each male dog shall be three dollars (\$3.00) per year, and for the keeping of each female dog five dollars (\$5.00) per year. All licenses shall expire on the first day of January of each year. No license shall be issued for less than one year unless the dog was brought into the City after the first day of January, in which case the cost of obtaining such license shall be proportionate to the cost of the yearly license; provided that no license shall be issued for less than three months.

SECTION II: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication, as required by law.
