



ORDINANCE NO. 289

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION EIGHT, OF ORDINANCE NO. 249 OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, MADISON COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PARKING OF VEHICLES AND REGULATING TRAFFIC IN TRAFFIC DISTRICT NO. THREE IN THE CITY OF REXBURG.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF REXBURG:

SECTION I: That Section Eight of Ordinance No. 249 of the City of Rexburg, State of Idaho, is amended to read as follows.

SECTION VIII: In traffic district No. Three any vehicles may be stopped or parked at the curb where the same is left parallel with the curb, the right hand side of such vehicle being adjacent to the curb, and no part of such vehicle being more than eight feet from the curb; provided that no vehicle shall be parked within 10 feet of any fire hydrant nor opposite, nor within five feet of any Avenue or Alley intersection, street crossing or cross-walk; provided further that no animal drawn vehicle shall be permitted to remain standing or parked at the curb longer than ten minutes and no vehicle shall be stopped upon the street or avenue except the same be parked as herein provided, unless in case of an emergency, or to allow another vehicle or pedestrian to pass, or when blocked by traffic.
