



ORDINANCE NO. 291

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IN THE STATE OF IDAHO, AND FOR THE APPROPRIATION TO THE SEVERAL FUNDS AND PURPOSES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1926.

BE IT ORDAINED By the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Rexburg:

SECTION I: That the revenue of the City of Rexburg, in the state of Idaho, for the Fiscal year 1926, derived from the taxes levied for said year are hereby appropriated to the several funds and in the several amounts following, to-wit:

Interest on City Bonds	\$7,500.00
Balance in General Fund, approx.	\$15,300.00

SECTION II: There is hereby levied on the taxable property in the City of Rexburg, in the State of Idaho, for the Fiscal year 1926, for the several funds, taxes as follows:

- Levy for General Purposes, 10 mills on the Dollar,
- Levy for Bon Interest, 7 mills on the Dollar,

Of the assessed valuation of said property for the year 1926, and the City Treasurer of the City of Rexburg is hereby authorized and directed to apportion all money received on account of said taxes to the said funds upon said basis.

SECTION III: From the receipts of the Water Works System of the City of Rexburg, for the Fiscal year 1926, there is hereby appropriated sufficient funds for the operation and maintenance of said Water Works System; and there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$1,850.00 from said receipts for interest on Water Works Bonds.

SECTION IV: From the receipts of the Ditch System of the City of Rexburg, for the Fiscal year 1926, there is hereby appropriated sufficient funds for the operation and maintenance of said Ditch System.

SECTION V: All money received from the sale of Lots in the City Cemetery, and all money received from the care of the Lots in the City Cemetery is hereby appropriated to the Cemetery Fund.

SECTION VI: All money received from the road Poll Tax, County Road & Bridge Tax during the Fiscal year 1926, is hereby appropriated to the Road & Bridge Fund.

SECTION VII: All the revenues of the City of Rexburg, for the Fiscal year 1926, derived from all sources of any kind, except revenues hereinbefore enumerated, are hereby appropriated to the General Expense Fund of the said City of Rexburg.

SECTION VIII: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption and approval, and upon its publication in the Rexburg Journal, a weekly newspaper printed and published in the City of Rexburg, State of Idaho, and having a general circulation therein.
