



ORDINANCE NO. 305

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED THE “THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG”, LEVYING TAXES FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES OF SAID CITY AND INTEREST ON THE BOND INDEBTEDNESS THEREOF, AND APPROPRIATING SUCH SUMS OF MONEY AS ARE BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF SAID CITY DEEMED NECESSARY TO DEFRAY ALL EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF SAID CITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 1930.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY the mayor and council of the city of Rexburg, in Madison County, State of Idaho:

SECTION I: That this ordinance be and is hereby termed “The Annual Appropriation Bill of the City of Rexburg” for the fiscal year, 1930.

SECTION II: There is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the limits of the City of Rexburg, in and for the year 1930, taxes for the several purposes and at the rates following: For General Revenue Purposes, 15 mills on the Dollar; For Interest on the Outstanding Obligation Bonds of said City, 7 mills on the Dollar.

SECTION III: That the City Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to certify said levies to the proper officers of Madison County of entry upon the tax rolls of County for Collection in the usual manner.

SECTION IV: That the City Treasurer is hereby directed to apportion the moneys received on account of taxes hereby levied, and from all other sources, to the several funds for which said levy as made and to which said moneys are appropriated, as in this ordinance provided.

SECTION V: That the revenues of the City of Rexburg for the fiscal year, 1930, from all sources received, are hereby appropriated to the several funds and purposes respectively, as follows which are hereby declared to be necessary for such purposes as shown by the budget of said year, to-wit:

- A. GENERAL EXPENSE FUND:** From moneys received on account of taxes levied and other available moneys there is hereby appropriated to the General Expense Fund of said City government, the sum of \$_____.
- B. WATER DEPARTMENT:** From revenues derived from the water works system of the city for the fiscal year 1930, and from money now on hand in the water works fund, there is hereby appropriated the amount necessary to defray the expense of operation and maintaining of said system during the fiscal year of 1930, and from such revenues there is hereby appropriate the sum of \$_____ for the sinking fund and interest on bonds issued

for water works expenses.

- C. STREET DEPARTMENT:** From moneys received on account of taxes levied therefor, there is hereby appropriated to the streets department of the city for the maintenance and improvement of streets and highways therein, the sum of \$_____.
- D. FIRE DEPARTMENT:** From moneys received on account of taxes levied therefor, there is hereby appropriated to the Fire Department of said city for the purpose of paying salaries and other expenses of operation and maintenance, the sum of \$_____.
- E. DITCH DEPARTMENT:** All moneys received from and on account of the irrigation system of said city and the distribution of water hereby to the inhabitants of said city, are hereby appropriate to the Ditch Fund for the payment of salaries and wages and other necessary expenses of operation and maintenance of the said irrigation system.
- F. Police Department:** From moneys received on account of taxes levied therefor, there hereby appropriated to the police department fund for the payment of salaries and other necessary expense, the sum of \$_____.
- G. CEMETERY FUND:** All money received from and on account of the sale of lots in the City Cemetery and all moneys received for the care of lots: in the Cemetery during the fiscal year, 1930 are hereby appropriated to the Cemetery Fund.
- H. ROAD AND BRIDGE:** All moneys received from Road Poll Tax and County road and bridge tax during the fiscal year, 1930, are hereby appropriated to the road and bridge fund.
- I. INTEREST ON BONDS:** From moneys received on account of taxes levied therefor, there is hereby appropriated for the payment of interest on outstanding General Obligation Bonds of the City, and for the sinking fund therefor, the sum of \$_____.
- J.** All revenues of the City of Rexburg received during the fiscal year 1930, not hereby otherwise appropriated are hereby appropriated to the General Expense Fund of said City.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall take affect and be in force from and after its passage and approvals and due publication as required by law.
