ORDINANCE NO. 307

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL EXPENSE FUND TO THE CEMETERY FUND OF THE CITY OF REXBURG APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF SUCH FUND FOR IMPROVEMENT, CARE AND UPKEEP OF THE CEMETERY AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF THROUGH THE CEMETERY MAINTENANCE BOARD.

WHEREAS, By ordinance heretofore duly passed and approved there was transferred from the cemetery fund to the general expense fund of the City of Rexburg all unexpended balances in the cemetery fund as of the 30th day of July 1930, and there was so transferred the sum of Four Hundred Sixty-four Dollars Forty Four Cents (\$464.44); and,

WHEREAS, The said amount of \$464.44 is now needed, and available for the improvement, care and upkeep of the cemetery, and

WHEREAS, The Rexburg Cemetery Maintenance District has been established and organized, and said district embraces the City of Rexburg, and the Rexburg Cemetery, and the Cemetery Maintenance Board of said district has taken over control of the cemetery and has planned to make certain improvements therein:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the Mayor and Council of the City of Rexburg:

SECTION I – That there be and is hereby transferred from the general expenses fund to the Cemetery fund of the City of Rexburg the sum of \$464.44.

SECTION II – The City Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer from the general expense fund to the credit of the cemetery fund the said sum of \$464.44, and to make all changes transfers and entries on the books of the treasurer's office, necessary to carry the provisions of this ordinance into effect.

SECTION III – There is hereby appropriated from the cemetery fund of the City of Rexburg the sum of \$464.44 for the improvement, care and upkeep of the cemetery maintenance board of the Rexburg Cemetery Maintenance District, and all expenditures, bills and claims to be paid out of said fund shall be presented to the council audited and paid by warrants in the usual manner.
