



ORDINANCE NO. 308

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 276 OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, FIXING THE SALARIES AND TIME OF PAYMENT THEREOF OF THE MAYOR, CONCILMEN, CITY CLERK, CITY ATTORNEY, CHIEF OF POLICE, SUPERINTENDENT OF WATER WORKS, CITY TREASURER, CITY PHYSICIAN, POLICE JUDGE, CHIEF OF FIRE DEPARTMENT, ASSISTANT CHIEF OF FIRE DEPARTMENT, ASSISTANT CHIEF OF FIRE DEPARTMENT AND PROBATION OFFICER OF THE CITY OF REXBURG REPEALING ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED By the Mayor and Council of the City of Rexburg:

SECTION I: That the salaries and compensation and times of payment thereof of the officers elective and appointive of the City of Rexburg are hereby fixed as follows:

Councilmen, One Hundred Sixty Dollars per annum payable quarterly.

Mayor, Three Hundred Twenty Dollars per annum, payable quarterly.

City Clerk, Thirteen Hundred and Twenty Dollars per annum, payable semi-monthly.

City Attorney, Four Hundred Eighty Dollars per annum, payable quarterly.

City Treasurer, Three Hundred Sixty Dollars per annum, payable monthly.

Chief of Police, Fifteen Hundred Dollars per annum, payable semi-monthly.

Superintendent of Water Works, Fifteen Hundred Dollars per annum, payable semi-monthly.

City Physician, One Hundred Dollars per annum, payable monthly.

Police Judge, Three Hundred Dollars per annum, payable monthly.

Chief of Fire Department, Fifteen Hundred Dollars per annum, payable semi-monthly.

Assistant Chief of Fire Department, Thirteen Hundred Eight Dollars per annum, payable semi-monthly.

Probation Officer, Three Hundred Sixty Dollars per annum, payable semi-monthly.

SECTION II: All ordinance and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III: An emergency existing therefore, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
