**ORDINANCE NO. 310**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 48 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 283 OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING CERTAIN POLICE, FIRE, SAFETY AND SANITARY REGULATIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE VARIOUS OCCUPATIONS, TRADES, BUSINESSES, PROFESSIONS, VOCATIONS, EMPLOYMENTS TRANSACTED, ENGAGED IN, EXERCISED OR CARRIED ON WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, MADISON COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO: IMPOSING A LICENSE TAX ON PERSONS, COMPANIES, ASSOCIATIONS OR CORPORATIONS ENGAGED IN, CONDUCTING OR CARRYING ON SUCH OCCUPATIONS, TRADES, BUSINESSES, PROFESSIONS, VOCATIONS, AND EMPLOYMENTS, TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF ENFORCING SUCH REGULATIONS, AND ALL OTHER POLICE AND REGULATORY ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO: FIXING THE AMOUNT OF LICENSE TAX TO BE CHARGED FOR EACH OCCUPATION, TRADE, BUSINESS, PROFESSION, VOCATION OR EMPLOYMENT: PRESCRIBING THE MANNER OF PAYING SAID LICENSE TAX AND FIXING THE LENGTH OF TIME FOR WHICH SAID LICENSE TAX SHALL APPLY: PRESCRIBING THE MANNER OF ASCERTAINING THE CLASS TO WHICH THE VARIOUS BUSINESSES BELONG: PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSE TAX CERTIFICATES AND REGULATING THE USE THEROF: PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE: REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND PROVIDING THE TIME FOR THE TAKING EFFECT WHEREOF.”**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

**SECTION I:** That section 48 of Ordinance Number 283 of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

**“SECTION XLVIII:** Each photographer and photograph gallery must pay a license tax of \$15.00 per annum, in advance for the twelve months ensuing the commencement of his, her or its business in the city, and for each twelve months or fraction thereof while so engaged.”
