



ORDINANCE NO. 315

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, LEVYING TAXES FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES OF SAID CITY AND INTEREST ON THE BONDED INDEBTEDNESS THEREOF AND SINKING FUND, AND APPROPRIATING SUCH SUMS OF MONEY AS ARE BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF SAID CITY DEEMED NECESSARY TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF SAID CITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1933.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO.

SECTION I: That this ordinance be and is hereby termed "The Annual Appropriation Bill of the City of Rexburg, Idaho for the Fiscal Year 1933.

SECTION II: That there is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the limits of the city of Rexburg, in and for the year 1933, taxes for the several purposes and at the rate following; for general purposes, 10 mills on each dollar of assessed value; for interest on outstanding bonds of the said city and sinking funds 10 mills on each dollar of assessed value.

SECTION III: That the City Clerk be and is hereby authorized and directed to certify said levies to the proper officials of Madison County for entry upon the tax rolls of the county for collections in the usual manner.

SECTION IV: That the City Treasurer is hereby directed to apportion the moneys received on account of taxes hereby levied and from all other sources, to the several funds for which said levy is made and to which said moneys are appropriated as in the ordinance provided.

SECTION V: That the revenues of the City of Rexburg for the fiscal year 1933, from all sources received, are hereby appropriated to the several funds and purposed respectively, as follows, which are hereby declared to be necessary for such purposes as shown by the budget of the City for said year, to wit;

- A. General Expense Fund** – From moneys received on account of taxes levied and other available moneys, there is hereby appropriated to the General Expense fund the sum of \$2,400.00
- B. Water Department** – From revenues received from the water-works system of the city for the fiscal year 1933 and from moneys now on hand in the water works fund, and other sources available, there is hereby appropriated the amount necessary to defray the expenses of operation and maintenance of said system during the fiscal year 1933 and from such revenues and for said purposes there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$12,700.00
- C. Street Department** – From moneys received on account of taxes levied therefore, there is hereby appropriated to the street department of the city for maintenance and improvement of streets lighting, the sum of \$5,000.00.
- D. Fire Department** – From moneys received on account of taxes levied thereof, there is hereby appropriated to the fire department of said city for the purpose of paying salaries and other expenses of operation and maintenance the sum of \$3,650.00
- E. Ditch Department** – From moneys received from or on account of irrigation system of the city and the distribution of water thereby to the inhabitants of the city, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$1,000.00 to the ditch fund, for the payments of salaries, wages and other necessary expenses of operation and maintenance of said system.

- F. Police Department** – From moneys received on account of taxes levied therefore, there is hereby appropriated to the police department the sum for payment of salaries and other necessary expenses the sum of \$2,400.00
- G. Interest and Sinking Fund** – For money received on account of taxes levied therefore, there is hereby appropriated for the payment interest on outstanding general obligation bonds for the city and for the sinking fund therefore, the sum \$13,000.00.
- H.** All revenues of the city of Rexburg received during the fiscal year 1933, not hereby appropriated otherwise, are hereby appropriated to the general expense fund of the said city.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after its passage and approval and due publication as required by law.
