ORDINANCE NO. 335

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THAT CERTAIN LAND DEDICATED FOR THE USE OF PUBLIC STREETS IN THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, IS NOT NECESSARY FOR THE SAME AND VACATING, ABANDONING AND DISCONTINUING SAID STREETS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Rexburg, Idaho.

SECTION I: The following described land not being necessary for the use of the people of the city of Rexburg, Idaho, or any other people, as a street, said land being more particularly described as follow:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 14 of the City of Rexburg, Madison County, Idaho, as per the recorded plat thereof and running thence West To the O.S.L.R.R. Right -of -Way; thence Northeasterly along the East Line of the Said Right-of -Way to the south line of Lot 2, Block 5 of the said Block 5; Thence East to the Southeast corner of said Block 5; thence North 18 rods to the North Boundary line of said City; thence East 99 feet, thence South 18 rods, thence east 40 rods; thence South 99 feet; thence West 40 rods, Thence South 40 rods; thence West 99 feet; thence North 40 rods to the place of beginning. Said street if hereby abandoned, discontinued and vacated.

PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR this 3rd day of November, 1937.
