**ORDINANCE NO. 476**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A "CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND" AND LEVYING A SPECIAL TAX NOT TO EXCEED IN AGGREGATE 2 MILLS IN ANY ONE YEAR. SAID FUND NEVER TO EXCEED IN AGGREGATE 2% OF THE ASSESSED VALUATION. SUCH CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND TO BE USED FOR. THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING AND/OR CONSTRUCTING, REPAIRING AND FURNISHING A CITY HALL FOR THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, AND PURCHASING NECESSARY OFFICE EQUIPMENT, PROVIDING WHEN THE ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

**SECTION I:** There is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the City Limits of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, and subject to taxation for the city purposes of said city government, a special tax not to exceed in aggregate 2 mills in any one year. Said special tax to be levied each and every year commencing with the year, 1968. Said fund never to exceed in aggregate 2% of the assessed valuation.

**SECTION II:** The moneys received from. said special tax shall be placed in a "Capital improvements

**SECTION III:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforce from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
