ORDINANCE NO. 489

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 1969, LEVYING TAXES FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES OF SAID CITY AND FOR INTEREST ON THE BONDED INDEBTEDNESS AND FOR SINKING FUNDS, AND APPROPRIATING TO THE SEVERAL DEPARTMENTS, OFFICES AND FUNDS OF THE SAID CITY GOVERNMENT SUCH SUMS AS MAY BE NECESSARY OR DEEMED NECESSARY BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF SAID CITY FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 1969.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: This ordinance shall be and is hereby termed the annual appropriation bill of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, for the calendar year 1969.

SECTION II: There is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the city limits of the City of Rexburg, and subject to taxation for the city purposes of said City Government at the rates following:

For general revenue purposes ten (10) mills on each dollar for assessed valuation.

For interest on outstanding general obligation bonds of the city, and for sinking fund to pay maturing installments of such bonds, eleven (11) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

For recreation and culture three (3) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

For Fire Department purposes four (4) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

For street improvements twelve (12) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

For capital improvements two (2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

SECTION III: The City Clerk is hereby empowered and directed to certify the foregoing to the proper officers of Madison County, Idaho, for entry upon the tax rolls of said County for the collection in the manner provided by law.

SECTION IV: The City Treasurer is hereby empowered and directed to apportion the moneys received on account of taxes hereby levied, and from all other sources, to the several funds for which levies are made and to which moneys are appropriated as in this ordinance provided.

SECTION V: The revenue of the City of Rexburg for the calendar year 1969, from all sources received are hereby appropriated to the several funds and purposes which are hereby declared to be necessary for such purposes as shown by the Budget of the City heretofore adopted for said calendar year, respectively as follows, to-wit:

- A. ADMINISTRATIVE DEPARTMENT – GENERAL EXPENCSE FUND: From moneys received on account of taxes levied and other available sources, there is hereby appropriated to the General Expense Fund, Administrative Departments, the sum of \$54,800.00
- B. PUBLIC SAFETY: From the moneys received on account of taxes levied and other available sources, there is hereby appropriated to the public safety (Police Department, Fire Department and Inspection Department) the sum of \$77,956.00
- C. WATER AND SEWER UTILITY FUND: From the revenue derived from culinary water sales, water meters and supplies, sewer service charges and sewer connections during the calendar year 1969 and other revenues available, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$76,200.00 to operate and maintain said water and sewer system and retire water and sewer bonds and interest.
- D. IRRIGATION DEPARTMENT: All moneys received on account of the irrigation system of the City of Rexburg, and distribution of water thereby to the inhabitants of the City, are hereby appropriated to the City Ditch Fund for the payment of salaries, wages and other necessary expense of operation and maintenance of said irrigation system, and there is hereby appropriated to the Ditch Fund for such purposes from moneys not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$10,200.00.
- E. STREETS AND ALLEYS: From moneys received on account of taxes levied therefore and other revenues available, there is hereby appropriated to the Streets Department of the City of Rexburg, for maintenance and improvement of public streets and alleys, the sum of \$127,809.00.
- F. PARKS, RECREATION AND AIRPORT: From moneys received on account of taxes levied therefore and other revenues available, there is hereby appropriated for the Parks, Recreation and Airport of the City of Rexburg, for maintenance and improvement thereof, the sum of \$15,900.00.
- G. PUBLIC HEALTH: From moneys received on account of taxes levied therefore and other revenues available, there is hereby appropriated for the maintenance of the public health nurse, the sum of \$1,849.00.
- H. BOND INTEREST AND REDEMPTION FUNDS: From moneys received on account of taxes levied therefore and other available sources, there is hereby appropriated for the payment of interest on outstanding general obligations bonds of said City and the payment of maturing installments on such indebtedness, the sum of \$43,576.00.
- I. SWIMMING POOL: From the moneys received on account of taxes levied therefore and other revenues available, there is hereby appropriated for general operating expenses of the swimming pool the sum of 6,250.00.
- J. GARBAGE COLLECTION: From moneys received on account of taxes levied therefore and other available sources, there is hereby appropriated to the Health and Sanitation Department for garbage removal and dump ground labor and expense the sum of \$13,500.00.

K. GENERAL FUND: All revenue of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, received during the calendar year 1969, not hereby otherwise appropriated is hereby appropriated to the General Fund of the City.

SECTION VI: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
