ORDINANCE NO. 620

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES, MOTOR AND OTHERWISE ON EITHER SIDE OF NORTH SECOND EAST STREET, CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO FROM RICKS AVENUE TO THE TETON RIVER BRIDGE; MAKING THE VIOLATION THEREOF A MISDEMEANOR AND SETTING FORTH THE PENALTY ON CONVICTION FOR SUCH VIOLATION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING WHEN SUCH ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rexburg, Idaho:

SECTION I: It shall be unlawful at any time to park vehicles, motor or otherwise on either side of North Second East Street, Rexburg, Idaho, from Ricks Avenue to the South side of the Teton River Bridge across said North Second East Street.

SECTION II: It shall be a misdemeanor for any person, firm or corporation to violate the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION III: Any person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00, or imprisonment in the City-County jail not exceeding six months, or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION IV: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION V: This Ordinance shall become effective after its passage and publication as provided by law.
