



ORDINANCE NO. 624

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION ONE SUBSECTION SEWER SERVICE RATE SCHEDULE OF ORDINANCE NO. 431 OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, BY PROVIDING INCREASED MONTHLY RATES FOR SEWER SERVICE FOR SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING UNITS AND MULTIPLE DWELLING UNITS, INCLUDING APARTMENTS AND DUPLEXES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO.

SECTION I: That Subsection Sewer Service Rate Schedule of Section one of Ordinance No. 431 of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEWER SERVICE RATE SCHEDULE

Sewer service shall be charged according to the following schedule:

CLASSIFICATION	MONTHLY RATE
Single family dwelling units and churches	\$2.50 flat rate
Multiple family dwelling units, including apartments and duplexes	\$2.50 flat rate first unit and \$1.25 each additional unit
Commercial, including restaurants, stores, garages, governmental buildings, offices, service stations, hotels, trailer courts, motels and commercial buildings with multiple uses.	50% of water bill or \$2.00 whichever is greater.
Schools, special uses and other unclassified units or users	After consultation with the City Clerk, the Mayor and City Council will set rates proportionate to the service rendered to such units or users.

SECTION II: The effective date of this Ordinance shall be September 9, 1980.
