



ORDINANCE NO. 667

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING THAT CERTAIN ROAD IN THE MILL HOLLOW SUBDIVISION AND HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS OF WAY AND EASEMENTS AND RESERVATION BY THE CITY OF RIGHTS OF WAY AND EASEMENTS OVER, ACROSS AND UNDER SAID PROPERTY FOR CITY UTILITIES AND PURPOSES; PROVIDING SAID STREET REVERT TO THE OWNERS OF ADJACENT REAL ESTATE, ONE-HALF ON EACH SIDE THEREOF; PROVIDING WHEN SAID ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That it is deemed expedient for the public good that the following described platted street of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, to-wit:

Beginning at a point that is S. 0E08'00" E. along the Quarter Section Line 1508.34 feet and N. 72E51'23" E. 30.00 feet from the Northwest Corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 6 North, Range 40 East, Boise Meridian, and running thence N. 72E51'23" E. 106.00 feet; thence S. 17E08'37" E. 216.00 feet; thence S. 72E51'23" W. 16.00 feet; thence N. 17E08'37" W. 200.00 feet; thence S. 72E51'23" W. 90.00 feet; thence N. 17E08'37" W. 16.00 feet to the point of beginning.

be, and the same is hereby vacated, closed and discontinued and it shall, and does hereby revert to the owners of the adjacent real estate, one-half (2) on each side thereof. However, the rights of way, easements and franchise rights of any lot owner, City of Rexburg, or public utility shall not be impaired thereby and the City reserves rights of way and easements under, over and across said vacated premises for City utilities and other City purposes. The Mayor and City Clerk are directed to execute to said owners in the name of the City of Rexburg, a Quitclaim Deed to said street so vacated and closed.

SECTION II: That said street so vacated is not necessary for the use of the City of Rexburg, Madison County, Idaho, and is not required for any city purposes other than possible future rights of way or easements for City utilities or other City purposes.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and due publication as provided by law.
