ORDINANCE NO. 675

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING ALL OF THAT PORTION OF FIRST EAST STREET BETWEEN THIRD AND FORTH SOUTH STREETS IN THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, AND DIRECTING THAT THE VACATED PROPERTY BE CONVEYED TO THE ADJOINING PROPERTY OWNERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That the following described platted street of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, to-wit:

All of that portion of the street known as First East Street in the City of Rexburg, Idaho, between Third and Forth South Streets, is hereby vacated, closed and discontinued for the exclusive use of the owners of the adjacent real estate as provided by the statutes of the State of Idaho. Title to said portion of the street so vacated shall revert to the adjoining property owners, and the Mayor and City Clerk are directed to execute to said owners in the name of the City of Rexburg, a Quitclaim Deed to the portion of said streets so vacated and closed as provided by law, subject to reversion to the City of Rexburg, Idaho, in the event the present property owners ever attempt to sell or dispose of said property.

SECTION II: The vacation of such portion of First East Street is deemed expedient for the public good as it will reduce traffic congestion and traffic hazards.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and due publication as provided by law.
