ORDINANCE NO. 680

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AND CLOSING PORTIONS OF THIRD WEST STREET IN BLOCKS 7 AND 8 OF THE ORIGINAL, REXBURG TOWNSITE AS HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS-OF-WAY, EASEMENTS AND FRANCHISE RIGHTS OF ANY LOT OWNER, PUBLIC UTILITY OR CITY OF REXBURG; PROVIDING THAT ALL OF SAID STREETS REVERT TO THE OWNERS OF THE ADJACENT REAL ESTATE, ONE-HALF ON EACH SIDE THEREOF; PROVIDING WHEN SAID ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That it is deemed expedient for the public good that the following described portions of the platted streets of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, to-wit: Those portions of Third West Street described as follows:

Beginning at the NW Corner of Lot 2 of Block 7 of the Original Rexburg Townsite and running thence West 99 feet to the NE Corner of Lot 1 of Block 8, townsite aforesaid; thence South 297 feet to the SE Corner of Lot 1 of Block 8, townsite aforesaid; thence East 99 feet to the SW Corner of Lot 2 of Block 7, townsite aforesaid; and thence North 297 feet to the point of beginning.

Beginning at a point which is West 330 feet from the NE Corner of Lot 1 of Block 8 of the Original Rexburg Townsite and running thence West 150 feet; thence North 33 feet; and running thence West 150 feet; thence North 33 feet; thence East 150 feet; and thence South 33 feet to the point of beginning.

be, and the same are hereby vacated, closed and discontinued and the City Council deems it in the best interests of the adjoining properties that the entire streets so vacated and closed revert to the owners of the adjacent real estate in said lots and blocks of the Original Rexburg Townsite. However, the rights-of-way, easements and franchise rights of any lot owner, City of Rexburg, or public utility shall not be impaired thereby and the City reserves rights-of-way and easements under, over and across said vacated premises for City utilities and other City purposes. The Mayor and City Clerk are directed to execute to said owners in the name of the City of Rexburg, Quitclaim Deeds to the portion of said streets so vacated and closed to the adjacent property owners in said lots and blocks of the Original Rexburg Townsite, as above described.

SECTION II: That said streets so vacated are not necessary for the use of the City of Rexburg, Madison County, Idaho, and are not required for any City purposes other than possible future rights-of-way or easements for City utilities or other City purposes.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its, passage, approval and due publication as provided by law.
