



ORDINANCE NO. 689

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION II OF ORDINANCE NO. 672 AND ADOPTING THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE, 1988 EDITION, COPYRIGHTED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS AND WESTERN FIRE CHIEFS ASSOCIATION; REQUIRING COPIES OF SAID CODE TO BE KEPT IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND FOR SEVERABILITY; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That Section II of Ordinance No. 672 is hereby repealed.

SECTION II: That the document known as the Uniform Fire Code, 1988 Edition, copyrighted by the International conference of Building Officials and Western Fire Chiefs Association is hereby adopted as the fire code of the City of Rexburg, Idaho. This Code prescribes among other things regulations and practices for the safeguarding to a reasonable degree of life and property from the hazards of fire and explosion arising from the storage, handling and use of hazardous substances, materials and devices, and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the use of occupancy of building or premises.

SECTION III: There has been on file, and there shall hereafter be kept on file, in the office of the Clerk three (3) copies of said Uniform Fire code, 1988 Edition, duly certified by the Clerk, for use and examination by the public.

SECTION IV: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment for any single violation.

SECTION V: The sections of this Ordinance are severable and the invalidity of a section shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections.

SECTION VI: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION VII: This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
