



ORDINANCE NO. 721

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION II OF ORDINANCE NO. 702 OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, AND ADOPTING THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 1991, COPYRIGHTED BY THE NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIATION, INC. FOR THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO; REQUIRING COPIES OF SAID CODE TO BE KEPT IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO:

SECTION I: That Section II of Ordinance No. 702 of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, is hereby repealed.

SECTION II: That certain document known as the National Electrical Code, 1991, copyrighted by the National Fire Protection Association, Inc., is hereby adopted as the Electrical Code of the City of Rexburg, Idaho. The purpose of this Code is the practical safeguarding of persons and property from hazards arising from the use of electricity.

SECTION III: There shall hereafter be kept on file, in the office of the Clerk, three (3) copies of said National Electrical Code, 1991, duly certified by the Clerk, for use and examination by the public.

SECTION IV: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment for any single violation.

SECTION V: The sections of this Ordinance are severable and the invalidity of a section shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections.

SECTION VI: This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
