## **Resolution 05-18-1932**

WHEREAS, on or about the 20<sup>th</sup> day of November, A.D. 1930, one Blanche Humphrey fell on the public side walk, on College Avenue, near the Post Office, in the City of Rexburg, and injured her knee, and as a result thereof was confined in Spencer's Hospital at Idaho Falls for approximately twenty days, and said Blanche Humphrey claimed the City of Rexburg was liable in damages for said injury by reason of an alleged defect in the sidewalk where said accident occurred; and,

WHEREAS the Mayor and Council of the city claimed that there was no defect in the sidewalk at said place and that the city could not be held liable for said injury, and the said matter having been submitted to the city attorney for his opinion, and he having given an opinion that the question of the liability of the city in the event of an action we would be one of fact to be a jury; and,

WHEREAS, said Blanche Humphrey and her husband Howard Humphrey have offered to compromise said matter, and accept in full settlement of all claims for damages arising out of said accident and injury, a sum equal to the amount which they were compelled to pay for hospital and surgical services for treatment of said injury, and they have submitted their claim therefor in the amount of \$304.00, and said claim was thereafter reduced to TWO HUNDRED, FIFTY-FIVE and 50/100 (\$255.50) DOLLARS: and.

WHEREAS it appears to the Mayor and Council that said last named sum is fair and reasonable for the services rendered said claimant, and that it will be in the best interest of the city that same be allowed and paid in compromise of the demand of said claimant.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Rexburg, Idaho:

That the claim of Mrs. Blanche Humphrey and her husband Howard Humphrey as described in the forgoing premises be, and the same is hereby, approved and allowed, and that the City Clerk be, and he is hereby, directed to draw a warrant on the City Treasury payable to said Blanche Humphrey, in payment of her said claim in the amount of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE and 50/100 --- (\$255.50) --- Dollars.
