## **Resolution 05-01-1935**

WHEREAS, the \$92,000.00 of the refunding bonds of the City of Rexburg heretofore authorized by proceedings of the Council, have been duly signed by the Mayor, the City Clerk and the City Treasurer and are now ready for delivery for exchange for the outstanding bonds of the City heretofore authorized to be refunded, and it has been agreed that the exchange shall be made through the Rexburg State Bank at Rexburg,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Rexburg that the City Treasurer be and she is hereby authorized and directed to deliver forthwith the said refunding bonds, in the amount of \$92,00.00, to the Rexburg State Bank aforesaid, for exchange for the outstanding bonds of the City described in the proceedings had for the issuance of said refunding bonds.

Mr. D.W. Stowell seconded the motion to adopt the resolution. The Mayor stated the question on the adoption of the resolution. On roll call the following members voted "Aye": Kelley, Webster, Peterson, Wright and Stowell. Absent and not voting: Shirley.

Bills were allowed.

The incoming Mayor was sworn into office by Mayor Porter.
