## **Resolution 03-17-1937**

A resolution calling for a City Election in and for the City of Rexburg, to be held on April 27<sup>th</sup>, 1937, and directing that Notices be posted, providing for Deputy Registrars and Judges of Election, was introduced by Councilman Hopkins, who moved its adoption; which motion was seconded by councilman Herdti, and unanimously passed by the council.
