Resolution 06-18-1941

Whereas, the City of Rexburg, a municipal corporation is sponsor of a certain works project administration project for the construction and erection of an armory building in the city of Rexburg, Idaho, said project being known as #50187, and in order to comply with the law with respect to such projects it is necessary that two of the members of the city council , or one member of the council and the mayor of the said city be designated and authorized to represent the said city as its agents in all matters pertaining to the said project, and that such designated persons or agents have authority to bind the said city in all matters pertaining to said project.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that D.W. Stowell and Joseph B DeMott, be and they are hereby designated and appointed to act as such agents for the said city pertaining to the said project; and they are hereby given full power and authority to represent, act for, and bind the said city in all matters pertaining to the said project, including signing of all papers in relation thereto until said building has been completed and finally approved and accepted by the Mayor and Council, or until further order of the council herein.

Jolley seconded the motion to adopt said resolution. The president of the council hereupon put the question on the adoption of said resolution; a vote was taken by roll call and the members of council voted as follows: DeMott, aye; Powell, aye; Jolley, aye; Cullmore, aye; Humphreys, aye. Absent and not voting M.D. Beal. There was no vote against its adoption.

Whereupon D. W. Stowell and Joseph B. DeMott were duly appointed and designated the agents of and for the said city with full power and authority to act for and in behalf of the said city as stated in the foregoing resolution.
