Resolution 03-05-1943

A Resolution calling for a city election in and for the city of Rexburg to be held April 27, 1943, and directing that notices be published in the local papers and posted in the various precincts; providing for registers and judges of election, was introduced to the Mayor. Powell moved that the resolution be adopted; recorded by Taylor and unanimously approved. The following places of election were designated:
