Resolution 09-23-1948

EXTRACTS FROM THE MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL GOVERNING BODY OF THE PUBLIC AGENCY OF THE CITY OF REXBURG, IDAHO, HELD ON SEPT. 23, 1948.

The following Resolution was introduced by Mayor DeMott, read in Full and considered:

Resolution of the City of Rexburg, Idaho, accepting the Grant Offer of the United States of America through the Civil Aeronautics Administration of a maximum sum of \$10,462.00 to be used in the improvement of the Rexburg Airport, and does hereby specifically ratify and adopt all statements, representations, warranties, covenants and agreements contained in the Project Application.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Rexburg, Idaho:

SECTION I. That the City of Rexburg shall accept the Grant Offer of the United States of America for the Purpose of obtaining Federal Aid for the development of the Rexburg Airport.

SECTION II. That the City Council hereby ratify and adopt all statements, representation, warranties, covenants and agreements contained in the Project Application.

SECTION III. That the Mayor of the City of Rexburg is hereby authorized and directed to sign the Grant Offer on behalf of the City of Rexburg, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest the signature of the Mayor and impress the official seal of said City on the aforesaid Grant Offer.
